



Welcome to Music Kindergarten! **We look forward to making lots of music with your child!**

This information comes in English as we have many foreign families, even in courses given in Swedish. Please let us know if you need information in other languages.

This is our schedule for the courses starting week 10:

*Courses given on **Mondays**: Week 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 18, 19, 20.*

*Courses given on **Thursdays & Fridays**: Week 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 17, 18, 19, 20.*

*Courses given on **Saturdays**: Week 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 17, 19, 20, 21.*

Every lesson takes 45 minutes. Our courses are not progressive, but each course will have some new aspects. As children in this age like repetitive moments it might be useful to join even the next course. Two or three children who would like to progress together can apply for “KiGa seniors” or “kompiskurs”.

Time slots: *The timeslot for your child is provided individually by mail as well as your teacher’s name and telephone number. This information will even appear on the invoice. Sometimes we adjust groupings for a good mix of ages. In some of the older groups we still have space for more children. We don’t invest in a lot of advertising – tell your friends instead!*

Teachers: *Name and telephone number will be provided on the invoice.*

How to find us: *Courses held at...*

...Helgeandsgatan 7: *As soon as you come to our area we would like to see big ears, open eyes and a curious mind in a calm body. Listen through the other doors – there is music everywhere! No running or shouting in the corridor, show respect for the other pupils.*

...Bredgatan 25: *Find the little garden house and entrance to the right.*

We ask you to leave shoes and jackets outside our rooms.

Parents: *One adult is always welcome to be present in the classroom. You may also wait in front of the classroom. **We ask you not to leave the building, in case your child would need your assistance during the lesson.** You don’t need to know how to play an instrument. The teacher will decide how to interact with you. Sometimes you will sing or play together, sometimes you just listen.*

We would like you to take the music home. Make your own diary with texts and melodies.

Arrive in time! 10 minutes before start of the lesson is suitable and prepares your child for a focused start.

Please be aware that your mobile should be off in the classroom.

You may take pictures/films, but please, ask all the others first.

Siblings: *Brothers or sisters, older or younger can be brought into the room when in right age and signed up for the class. Otherwise they need to wait outside with an adult present at all time.*

Cancel lessons: *In case your child can’t participate in a lesson we would appreciate that you let the teacher know in advance. Missed group lessons can not be replaced.*

Fee: *The course will be charged by invoice, which will be sent by mail during week 10.*

Interesting things to do together with your child:

Join us at the inauguration of our new facility at Helgeandsgatan 7 on the 4th and 5th of May!

Our students in all ages are preparing for different concerts with a lovely mixture of instruments and styles.

There will also be a special guest: Göran Söllscher, guitar.
